

WHY DO SOME PEOPLE GET ALL THE GOOD STUFF? It has to be INSIDER INFORMATION!!!

What is insider information and how should it be treated? According to Webster an insider is: A person who is in a position of power or has access to confidential information or one who is in a position to have special knowledge of affairs of or to influence the decision of a company. Or said another way: A person who has access to special information.

That is a mouthful in itself but most laymen (most strikers) would break that down to mean someone who has access to information that not everyone may know and in the case of Silver Strikes we're talking about WHAT, WHEN, WHERE and HOW MANY of something.

Silver Strikers are concerned about the what, when, where and how many when it has to do with new releases, short runs, errors or any one of the things which might make a strike more valuable than normal or to the real collector a prized item for the collection.

Where does insider information come from? It has to come from one of four places, #1. Gaming, #2. IGT (International Gaming Technologies), #3. The Casino (or employees of the casino). #4. Common Sense (real insider information) - that is one who pays attention to what is going on and second-guesses how it might work or play out.

Gaming only releases information concerning what has been approved. IGT does not release any information and has tried very hard to stop any of its employees from releasing any information. The Casinos are free to do as they see fit. You can guess as you want.

A word of caution when gathering silver strike information is to UNDERSTAND YOUR SOURCE. The best person, in the casino, for information is the Slot Manager not the cage personnel, not the slot tech, not the change person. All of these people are willing to help you and will give you an answer but if you talk to five different people you'll most likely have four or more different responses. When you talk to the slot manager you should take what he tells you with a grain of salt. He does not intentionally lie to you but his program is a moving target. The plan can change.

Now if someone develops a relationship with some or all of the sources that's OK. They do not have any obligation to pass on what they know. However, if it is discovered that, because of the inside information from #1, #2 or #3, they are profiting from that information at the expense of others it becomes a whole different ballgame. In that case go to The Gaming Commission with proof of your accusations such as who, what, where and how and if it is proven to be true you'll see some changes. The chippers can tell you how that works. Remember if you're going to point fingers you better be right.

Now we need to state some givens that may not be popular but they are the way they are and there isn't anything we can do about them.

1. This is a game of chance and fair and ethical, as we know it, do not apply when it comes to the casinos. The Gaming Commission sets the general rules and whether we like it or not that is the way it is. IGT as the holder of the patent for the Silver Strike program also has some say. The casinos have to stay within the guidelines handed down to them but can wade through the minutiae as they see fit.

2. The Silver Striker Club has drawn up a set of bylaws and the only place those by-laws apply is between club members. I'm talking about the way club members act and how they treat each other. Fair and ethical

come into play here.

3. Nothing says that a club member has to share or pass on information they have gleaned from their contacts. However, if information comes to or is given to the club as a club it should be disseminated to all members.

Some of the latest examples of what I'm talking about are: Sundowner Closing resulting in a short last release, Palms \$200s, Sahara Error, Four Queens \$200s etc. The list can go on and on.

How many people have rushed to obtain a strike and paid a premium for it only to find out it is a common? How many people have stood in line for something only to find out what they got was nothing more than a common? How many people have raced for something to find out later that they did not have to race at all but could have taken their time? And last but not least how many have missed out because they did not do any of the above?

Most people gather all the information they can, decide what has to be done and then determine if they are willing to take the needed steps to accomplish that goal. Gathering the information from any of the sources takes a lot of time and footwork, those who are willing to put in the time sometimes get the information.

It's a game and each person has to, gather the information, figure out how she or he is going to play it and do it. Pick what you want to do and go with it but don't be mad at someone who has chosen a different route and achieved what you wanted to do but were not able to. Remember the time when you achieved your goal and someone else failed.

NEW SILVER STRIKE MACHINE TO BE IN PLAY IN JUNE?

Are you ready?? The trade out will be first to come – as of this writing 18 games have been ordered in Northern Nevada. They include NEW locations like Rail City and the Alamo. Boomtown and the Sparks Nugget are also on the list to receive machines. There are several orders in the south also and there should be some of the new machines in play by time of the convention. Along with the new machines will come many new designs. History in Silver Strikes is about to be made.

These machines will dispense up to 6 different strikes, which can be either \$10 or \$40 or mixed. They will be of the "red-white-blue" concept. The strikes will remain as currently produced but the plastic capsule will be larger.

NON NEVADA SILVER STRIKES STRIKES ISSUED BY ILLINOIS CASINOS

Hello gang! It's time for a review of strikes from Illinois. This month's report will be short and sweet since there was only one casino in Illinois that had silver strikes - the Casino Queen, East St. Louis, Ill. They offered 2 sets of zodiac strikes. The logo side is the same but on the reverse, one set has 1996, the other has zodiac. The set that has zodiac are a little harder to find. In fact, I still need the Libra and the Aries if anyone has any extras.

The zodiac sets have the GDC mint mark and the .999 is on the rim. The Casino Queen also had 3 Babe Ruth strikes which have the S mint mark with .999 on the silver. There are also 4 \$20 strikes. They are very attractive strikes depicting Blackjack, Dice, Royal Flush and Slot Machine. They have no mint mark. Well folks, that's it for Illinois. I'll be around next month for the state of Iowa.

"WINNING" ON A SILVER STRIKE MACHINE

Those that play the Silver Strike machines a great deal will tell you that on average a silver strike will cost you about \$14-\$14.50 to win. That's not to say that one can't play \$100 and get "0" or "15." The machine is a form of gambling and "luck" is a part of the equation.

The casinos have terminology like: "Hold" – which relates to how much they want to keep; "Hit Frequency" – which determines how often any win is recorded. The "old" machines obtained from Anchor Games do NOT allow the casino to change the "Hold", but it is anticipated that the NEW IGT games will.

The one basic of the game that doesn't change is the fact that a silver strike machine is based on 64 stops per reel. This means that to figure your odds on winning the BIG \$\$\$ (3 - 7's -bottom row), take 64x64x64. Your right, odds are 1 in 262,144 that you're going home with the \$1000.
