I played the 40 machine on august 6th and received the last house coin that the 4 queens had. I went back in October when the Halloween drop normally would have happened and they had more of the house coin. I won a few and was putting them away tonight when I noticed the difference.

So above is the original from the June 2018 release. Below is a photo of the house coin between when they started and aug 6th. I'm calling it HC#1



HC#1 shown above has a darker pigment of the sky and the original has more blue in it noticeable around the edges. Also HC#1 above also does not have any ridges in the wolfs face just the nose and the eyes that are the wolf in the sky. I don't know when they put in the newest house coin but it was sometime after August 6th and Halloween weekend. I will call it HC#2. There is a difference on HC#2 and it's photo is below.



As you can see above when they put in HC#2 after August 6th of 2020 this batch has the original sky color with the blue around the side and top edges. The ridges are back in the wolfs face in the sky but now the wolf reflection in the water is silver with no coloration and ridges.

I don't know if anyone noticed it already but hope it could make 2020 seem a little more interesting. This is Jeffrey Lyon SS-1887.
