Proposed policy changes

These proposals will be voted on by the membership at our business meeting

Proposed: \$5.00 processing fee for all new memberships received after July 1, 2002.

This is to help defray the costs involved with processing new applications like providing a directory and setting up into the database.

Proposed: Any member that fails to pay his/hers membership dues by the renewal date shown on their label and membership card, (which is due the first of the month in which joined) will be automatically granted a 30 day extension. Delinquency thereafter will result in the membership being cancelled, membership number permanently retired, name removed from roster, and rejoining subject to the \$5.00 processing fee.

Proposed: increase in cost of obtaining a roster: To \$8.00 each

As with any business or organization today increased operating cost are forcing prices upward. Your Silver Strikers organization is also feeling this impact. In order to compensate for the increase in operating cost (postage and printing), the \$3 increase is necessary. This will leave the membership dues as is at \$10.00 per person per year. With the membership over 425, and the amount of information contained on the roster, the increased cost of production is to be expected.

Proposed: Nominations for *Silver Strike of the Year* AND to the *Hall of Fame* are to be made from strikes DEFINED ONLY THOSE SILVER STRIKES PRODUCED UNDER THE SUPERVISION AND SOLD TO THE CASINO BY ANCHOR GAMING (NOW IGT) IN CONJUNCTION WITH THEIR PATENTED "SILVER STRIKE PROGRAM."
