One hundred and two Silver Strikers met at the Four Queens Hotel & Casino on June 27-29, 2015 to participate in the casino's summer Strike tournament.

The Queens' Director of Slots Shaun Webster loaded his eight strike machines with generously spaced four blue capsules – Godzilla, Dr. Jekyll, Dracula's Bride, Wolfman – and one red capsule, Dracula. All eight machines were vigorously played while accompanied by jovial banter of nearby fellow strikers. Many players sought 30 clear strikes to redeem later for one of the casino's new \$300 Silver Strikes, Frankenstein and Bride.

After three spirited rounds of tournament play on Shaun's Red, White and Blue slot machines, Michael Donatelli of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania was declared the winner and recipient of the \$2,692 first place prize during the awards ceremony with champagne and cake hosted by Shaun.

## Our friend Dan Hanagriff



Last week we celebrated Independence Day and the heroes that made this great country possible. Of course at a much different level, our Silver Strikers Club has had its heroes too.

Those of us who remember Dan Hanagriff would probably say they remember Dan as a nice guy, a short of stature round guy, a guy from Louisiana who stuttered. Dan was an accomplished stutterer. That might be what most people would recall. But Dan had passion.

Most strikers don't know that Dan drove from Louisiana, to Cripple Creek, Colorado to pick up an older Silver Strike machine from Johnny Nolan's casino and then he delivered it to the storage location in Las Vegas for our future museum. But wait, there is more to this story, Dan had visited Nolan's the prior October and spent many hours in person and on the phone convincing the casino to donate this machine. After the casino commitment was made, Dan rented a u-haul trailer and permanently modified the back bumper on his older Cadillac (Big Red) for a trailer hitch. Dan made the round trip driving solo, fighting spring snow storms near Denver to complete his mission to make sure the Strikers Club secured this machine.

We also remember Dan hanging around the strike machines in Vegas talking up silver strikes and the club with the tourists and he always had applications for signing up. He would explain the different strike values and how our club worked, always encouraging new membership. He was always buying selling or trading near the machines. At home in Lake Charles, Dan was Dan, he used to visit the different chippers and strikers club meetings in the south always talking up strikes and the club. Dan was truly a missionary for silver strikes and continued to communicate (in most cases by hand written letters) with these new friends, until his passing.

At the CC&GT&CC convention one year, (now this IS back in the day), Dan had built a large wooden bookcase-like display as a presentation platform for \$200 strikes. Dan was displaying his \$200 strikes and some harder to get strikes that had been loaned to him for this event. Please be aware that this display was large, wooden, painted white and heavy. Also be aware that Dan was not prepared for moving this object from the loading dock to the convention floor. In Dan's way he got that done, Union's do have a heart, and Dan did have the passion. There was tremendous positive comment about Dan's \$200 strike presentation, with one exception. This exception pointed out \$200 strikes not represented and that Dan had included a \$200-like walking liberty coin that was not casino related. After Dan had heard enough and I might add without stuttering, Dan explained why he had created this display and brought it from Louisiana for this convention. Most people did not know that Dan had crashed his pickup getting this display to Las Vegas (rolled it over outside of Kingman; busted display, wood, debris, \$200 strikes all over the highway), and that the display was totally rebuilt and painted in Las Vegas with the help from some of Dan's friends. After that convention, Dan became "Gator Dan".

No one can forget him signing up to be a club officer, well, no one else would, and as such assuming the job of newsletter publisher. Now, Dan was in no way a publisher,
