


















\$200 SILVER STRIKES BECOMING POPULAR

Tried for the first time in 1995, the \$5 silver strike slot machine didn't last very long due to a lack of play. Then some of the casinos sold off their remaining inventory of \$200 strikes. This caused several collectors to get interested in these one pound of silver with a face value of \$200 strikes. The original artwork was a walking eagle but did have the casino logos. The Eldorado in Reno decided this was a good way to make some extra money so they had designs made and sold them through their gift shop. The Imperial Palace decided it was a good way to stimulate play in the \$10 machines by offering to exchange 20-\$10 strikes for the \$200. Others have followed suit with this concept.
